Notes to Introducer

1. The above introduction is meant as a general example only. We find it is more meaningful if, rather than reading the intro verbatim, you share from your heart how you see Nate's message relating to your business and why you think it is important to your audience.
2. Whenever possible, it is helpful if Nate can spend 5-10 minutes beforehand with the person who will introduce him.
3. Please note that Nate does not walk on stage immediately after the introduction. As soon as the introduction is given, an introductory video begins to play. Nate will enter stage at the end of the video.
4. If you wish, during the intro, elaborate on any points (see below) from Nate's background that will resonate with your audience:
 - Training Officer of Blue Angels
 - After several combat deployments, Nate became a fully qualified F/A-18 Flight Instructor and Head Signals Officer, teaching all aspects of fighting and flying F-18's, including landing them on aircraft carriers
 - Led one of the most successful teams in Blue Angel history
 - Recently graduated from the world-renowned Navy Fighter Weapons School "TOPGUN" as an Adversary Instructor, where he was privileged to put the lessons he learned as a Blue Angel to the test
